



SWI: Alighting from a Vehicle

When a team is driving around a control area and the target species (i.e. goats) are spotted in close proximity to the vehicle, the following procedure should be followed when getting out of the vehicle to pursue them.

Scenario 1: The animals are on the passenger's side of the vehicle.

- The driver is to take the position 5 m to the front of the vehicle and in line with the passenger's side of the vehicle.
- The rear right passenger is to take the position 5 m to the rear of the vehicle and in line with the passenger's side of the vehicle.
- The front left passenger is to take the position at the left front tyre of the vehicle.
- The rear left passenger is to take the position at the left rear tyre of the vehicle.

No person is to move forward, chamber a round or fire until everyone is ready.

Scenario 2: The animals are on the driver's side of the vehicle.

- The driver is to take the position at the right front tyre of the vehicle.
- The rear right passenger is to take the position at the right rear tyre of the vehicle.
- The front left passenger is to take the position 5 m to the front of the vehicle and in line with the driver's side of the vehicle.
- The rear left passenger is to take the position 5 m to the rear of the vehicle and in line with the driver's side of the vehicle.

No person is to move forward, chamber a round or fire until everyone is ready.

NB: *While this procedure has been developed, it may be modified to suit the members of the Field Team undertaking the activity and the activity location. It is important that all members of the team are aware of what the planned course of action is when alighting from a vehicle, and that safe distances, directions of travel and directions of fire are maintained.*
